PTS MESSUT LTD – GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

By signing up for the fair either personally with the trade fairs, via the website or by accepting the offer made by the organizer, we agree to participate in the fair and comply with PTS Messut LTD's general terms of participation and other terms and conditions.

1. Exhibitors and products

Exhibitors may be importers, manufacturers, producers and their authorized representatives of the products mentioned in the registration form, as well as the aforementioned Joint Stands and Information Stands. Exhibitors may also be public administrations, organizations, clubs, cities and municipalities.

The Organizer has the rights to remove exhibits and products or services that may be hazardous or disturbing to other exhibitors or to the public.

2. Registration as an exhibitor and invoice for the exhibition stand

Registration as an exhibitor is done either by oral agreement or by sending a written or electronic registration to the Organizer. Upon receipt of the registration the Organizer accepts the exhibitor's registration and confirms it in writing to the exhibitor. The organizer have also the right to reject the registration. Participation will be billed before the fair in early June. Valid VAT is added to all prices. The exhibitor shall not, without the permission of the organizer, rent or surrender the stand further.

3. Revocation of the Stand

The exhibitor is entitled to cancel his / her participation in writing or orally without penalty within 14 days of the date of the order confirmation sent by the organizer. If the stand is canceled more than sixty (60) days before the event, 30% of the total fee will be charged. If the registration is made less than thirty (30) days before the start of the event, the reservation is binding from the date of registration and the stand will be invoiced immediately and any cancellation will be charged 50% of the total price.

4. Building the Stands

The exhibitor is responsible for the erection, decoration, dismantling, removal, cleaning and disposal of his / her own stand. The exhibitor is responsible for all costs incurred by his stand for work, supplies or any other costs incurred by the organizer of his stand, including subcontractors and the like. The organizer has the right to limit the size of the exhibition.

The exhibitor must take into account the following:

- Authorization is required for erecting two-tier exhibition structures.
- The exhibitor must provide adequate weights and fixings for the tents.

5. Setting up the samples

The exhibitor must first approve the following measures with the organizer:

- The mention of all non-exhibitors, his principal and representatives in the exhibition stand. Names Can be mentioned free of charge, but they must be agreed upon.
- All advertising, distribution and other activities outside the exhibitor's own stand.

6. Insurance

The exhibitor is responsible for any damage, theft, theft or other damages occurring in his / her stand's structures, equipment and exhibits, etc.

The exhibitor is responsible for any damage to property or property caused by any structure, equipment, exhibit or activity or subcontractor in his / her stand, to third parties (such as a fair or other exhibitors), the Organizer or the Exhibition Area.

The exhibitor is responsible for obtaining appropriate personal, property, vehicle and liability insurance.

The event organizer has liability insurance. The Organizer shall be responsible for the actions of its own staff or any damage caused to third parties by the Equipment and Builders of the Organizer.

7. Electric current and work

The event organizer is responsible for the general lighting of the area. The exhibitor will electronically arrange for the organizer the electrical current required by the organizer, as well as the necessary installation work. The electrical installation is carried out by the installation company Alahärmän Sähkö LTD, chosen by the organizer. The organizer charges electricity and installation, as well as any items that may have been lost by the stand. The organizer will not be liable for any damage caused by power outages.

8. Fire and other safety

For fire safety, observe the general laws and regulations in force. Access routes must be kept open for emergency exit. Presentation of equipment that could potentially jeopardize fire safety must be subject to prior authorization by the fire service. Smoking is permitted only in separate smoking areas. When presenting machines and other tools, the requirements of the Occupational Safety and Health Act and Regulations must be observed.

9. Security

The organizer is responsible for guarding and security in the fair area, but is not responsible for any damage or loss of goods, structures or the like.

10. Observations

The exhibitor is responsible for the proper prior checking of films, video programs, other visuals and recordings presented by the organizer's premises, as well as for the music and other works he has made for copyright payments. Performances must not interfere with other exhibition halls.

11. Passes, exhibit racks and parking permits

Exhibitors' agents and subcontractors as well as all exhibitors in the exhibitor's trade fairs must have a passage issued by the organizer on the preparation / construction day. At all other times the aforementioned parties must have the wristbands provided by the organizer in order to go smoothly in the fairground. The exhibition stand includes the number of exhibit racks included in the stand. There are also additional pay-per-view exhibit racks available for the fair.

For the fair, parking permits are also available that entitle to free parking in the parking area for exhibitors.

12. Exhibitor information

The name and presentations of the exhibitor are published free of charge under the title numbering list in the list of exhibitors, which will be published both in electronic services and in the Power Truck Show's guide and in the magazine.

13. Force majeure

The Organizer is not responsible for delays and damages caused by cancellation or transfer of a trade fair to another time due to force majeure. An overriding obstacle is the event outside the empowerment of the organizer, which the Organizer could not reasonably take into account at the time of the conclusion of the contract and the consequences of which the Organizer could not reasonably have avoided.

14. Other terms

Lillbacka Powerco LTD has exclusive rights to restaurant operations in the exhibition area.

The conditions for participation in Finnish are considered as a basis for handling possible cases of interpretation.

Disputes between the parties, which cannot otherwise be resolved, will be dealt with in the South Ostrobothnia District Court.
